Estates Administration

Some further improvements have been made when opening a file to obtain a Certificate of Appointment!

Gather Estate Information now contains a new **Add Beneficiary Information** button if you wish to capture the beneficiary information at this point. However, it is not mandatory to complete the beneficiary details at the **Gather Estate Information**; you can still choose to wait to complete the appropriate beneficiary dialog questions at the Affidavit of Service and Notice of an Application template dialogs.

In addition, the Beneficiary Dialog questions have been separated as between the questions that apply to the Affidavit of Service (Forms 74.6 and 74.16) and the questions that apply to the Notice of an Application (Forms 74.7 and 74.17).

Lastly, the question at the Beneficiary Dialog that asked if the Applicant is also a beneficiary has been removed – if the Applicant is also a beneficiary, they can be selected at the “All Other Beneficiaries” option.
